Diesel is looking for his forever home and would love to join your family.

He is a five year old, male American Staffordshire cross who is both desexed and microchipped and the City of West Torrens in Adelaide is seeking a new home for him to relocate to.

Diesel has been assessed by dog behaviourists as not showing aggression around other dogs (even while eating) or when being handled by people. He does, however, become highly excited around cats and his propensity to chase and catch cats has unfortunately led to Diesel being the subject of a Dangerous Dog Order. This means he must be kept in a securely enclosed environment at home and restricted with a muzzle and lead while in public.

All parties involved with Diesel agree that finding him a home where he is not tempted by cats, or able to escape and wander the streets, is in everyone's best interests.

The City of West Torrens will pay for Diesel's first year of dog registration in your council area, training requirements and also the cost of ensuring he has up-to-date vaccinations at the time that he is rehoused.
